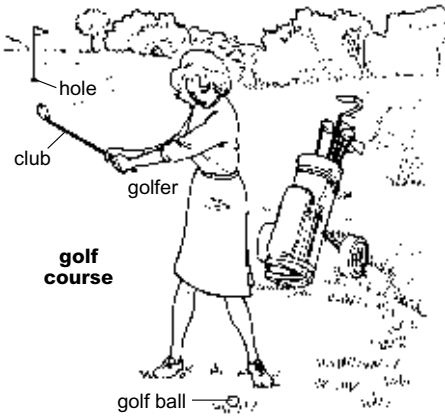
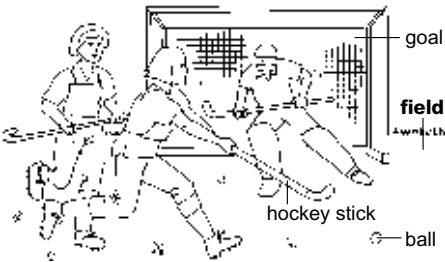


## 8 golf



- a game in which each player uses a **golf club** (= a kind of stick) to hit a **golf ball** (a small hard ball) into a series of nine or eighteen **holes** on a large area of land called a **golf course**. One game of golf is called a **round** (of golf). An act of hitting the ball is a **shot**. The winner is the player who succeeds in going round the course with the smallest number of shots. A person who plays golf is a **golfer**.

## 9 hockey



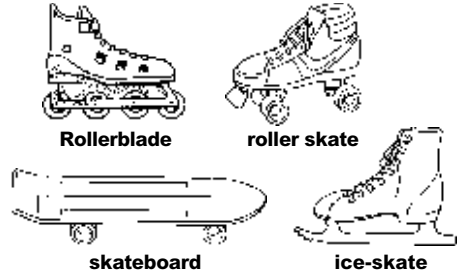
- a game (in *AmE* called **field hockey**) played on a **field** by two teams of eleven players each. Each player uses a **hockey stick** (= a kind of curved stick) to hit the **ball** (which is small and hard) into a **goal**. Hockey which is played on ice using **skates** is called **ice hockey** (*AmE* **hockey**). Ice hockey is played with a wooden **puck** instead of a ball.

## 10 indoor sports

- physical exercises that are done indoors, often using special equipment such as bars and ropes: **gymnastics** (*noun* U); a person who does gymnastics: **gymnast**
- energetic physical exercises (often done to music) that increase the amount of oxygen in your blood: **aerobics** (*noun* U)
- lifting heavy objects as an exercise: **weightlifting** (*noun* U); the objects which are lifted: **weights**; a person who does this form of exercise: **weight-lifter**

- a piece of equipment for jumping up and down on: **trampoline**; exercise which is done using this equipment: **trampolining** (*noun* U)

## 11 skating

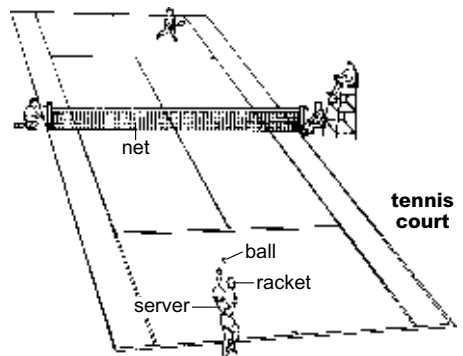


- to move over ice wearing boots with thick metal blades (**ice-skates**) on the bottom: **skate**; the name of the activity: **skating** (*noun* U), **ice-skating** (*noun* U); a person who skates: **skater**
- a large area of ice, or a building containing a large area of ice, that is used for skating on: **ice rink**, **skating rink**
- to skate over the ground wearing a type of shoe with small wheels on the bottom (**roller skates** or **Rollerblades**): **roller skate**; the name of the activity: **roller skating** (*noun* U); a person who roller skates: **roller skater**
- to stand on and ride a narrow board with wheels attached to it (a **skateboard**): **skateboard**; a person who skateboards: **skateboarder**

## 12 table tennis

- a game (also called **ping-pong**) with rules like tennis in which two or four players hit a light plastic **ball** across a **table** with a small light **bat**.

## 13 tennis



- a game played on a **tennis court** by two or four players who hit a **tennis ball** to each other across a **net** using **tennis rackets**. A game of tennis played by two players is called **singles** and one which is played by four players is called **doubles**. In a game of tennis, players play many
