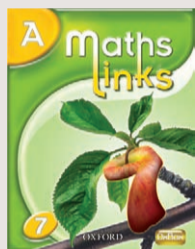

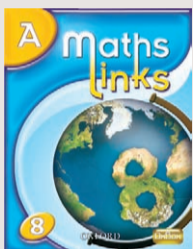
BOOK A

Focuses on **Levels 2-3**, with some additional reference to **Level 4**, to help ensure mastery of **Level 3**.

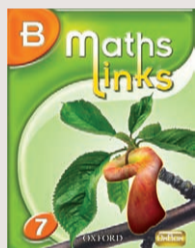


Year 9 Student Book A

Focuses on **Levels 4-5**. Each Homework Book includes a FREE CD-ROM of the appropriate Student Book.

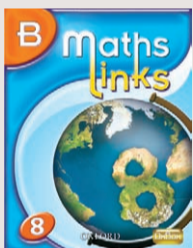
Year 9 Practice Book A

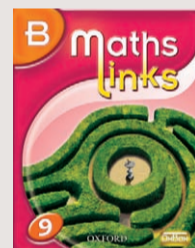
Year 7 Student Book B

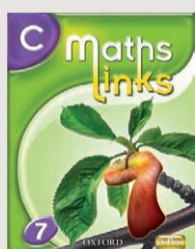

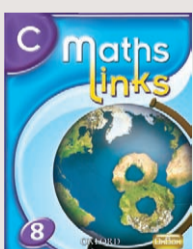

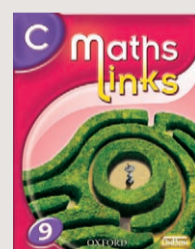
