**deportista** *adjective* sporty; **soy muy deportista** I do a lot of sport; **Jack es muy buen deportista** Jack's very good at games.

sports; **club deportivo** sports club; **ropa deportiva** sports clothes, casual clothes.

**derecha**<sup>1</sup> *noun Fem.* **1** right; **gira a la derecha** turn right; **conducir por la derecha** to drive on the right; **la segunda calle a la derecha** the second road on the right; **2** right hand; **escribo con la derecha** I write with my right hand; **3 la derecha** the right (*in politics*); **ser de derechas** to be right-wing.

**derecho**<sup>1</sup> *noun Masc.* **1** right; **tener derecho a** to have a right to; **ienes derecho a reclamar** you've got the right to claim; **los derechos humanos** human rights; **2** law; **estudiar derecho** to study law; **derecho penal** criminal law; **3 derechos de autor** royalties.

**derecho**<sup>2</sup> *adverb* straight; **ponlo derecho** put it straight; **sigas todo derecho** go straight on; **siéntate derecho** sit up straight.

**derecho**<sup>3</sup>/**derecha**<sup>2</sup> *adjective* **1** right; **el guante derecho** the right glove; **en la esquina superior derecha** in the top right-hand corner; **2** straight; **no está derecho** it's not straight.

**derramar** *verb* [17] to spill; **he derramado el café en la alfombra** I've spilt the coffee on the carpet.

**derramarse** *reflexive verb* [7] to spill; **se derramó la leche** the milk has spilt.

**derribar** *verb* [17] **1** to demolish (*a building or wall, for example*); **2** to break down (*a door*); **3** to shoot down (*a plane*).

**derrotar** *verb* [17] to defeat.

**des** *verb* SEE **dar**.

**desabrochar** *verb* [17] to undo (*a jacket or shirt*).

**desabrocharse** *reflexive verb* [17] to undo; **se desabrochó la chaqueta** he undid his jacket.

**desafilado/desafilada** *adjective* blunt.

**desafortunadamente** *adverb* unfortunately.

**desafortunado/desafortunada** *adjective* **1** unlucky (*a person*); **2** unfortunate (*an event*).

**desagradable** *adjective* unpleasant.

**desanimado/desanimada** *adjective* discouraged.

**desaparecer** *verb* [35] **1** to disappear; **la tradición está desapareciendo** the tradition is dying out; **2** to go missing.

**desaparición** *noun Fem.* disappearance.

**desaprovechar** *verb* [17] to waste; **han desaprovechado mucho papel** they've wasted a lot of paper.
