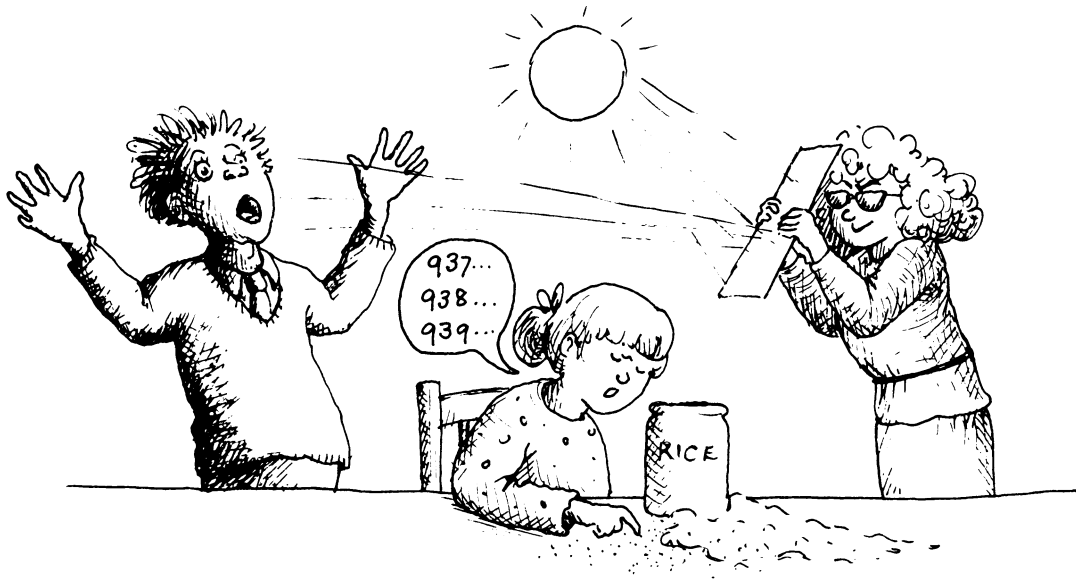


Duffinitions
