

# Synonym Pairs

*Synonym Pairs* is a game for two or more players.

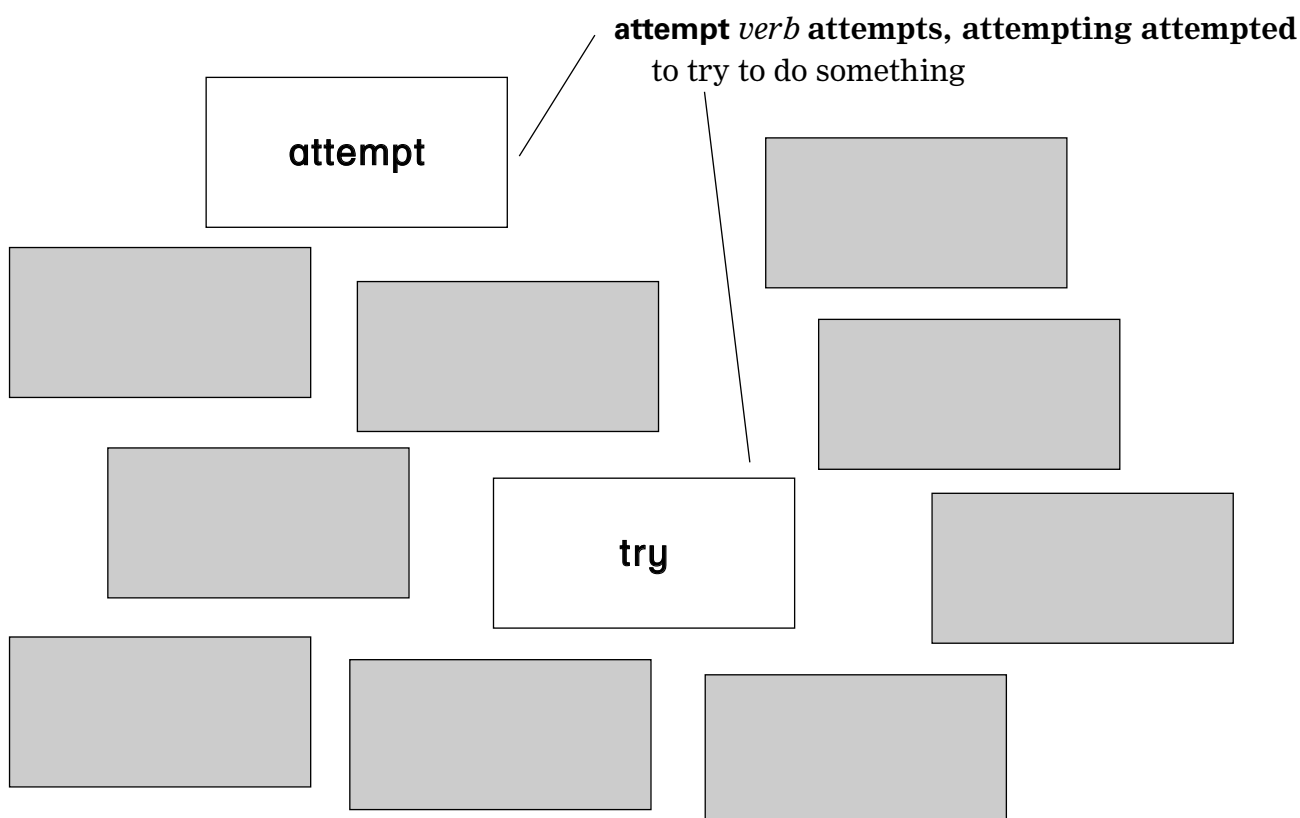
All you need is a set of cards like the ones on page 16.

The object of the game is to win as many pairs of cards as you can by matching the synonyms – either by luck, or by memory.

At the start of the game all the cards are placed face down and mixed up.

When it is your turn, flip over two of the cards so that everyone can see them. If they are synonyms, keep them and have another go. If not, replace them, face down, exactly where they came from and let the next player have a turn.

The dictionary is the referee. Look up **both** words: if **one** of the words is in the definition of the other word, then they count as synonyms.



You can make up your own games of *Pairs*, using blank cards.

Use the dictionary to find pairs of synonyms and write them on the cards.

The other players do the same. Then you mix them up and play the same way as before.
