1 Look

Framework Objective: Use talk to organise, sequence and clarify... feelings and events

- What can you see in the photograph?
- What are the children wearing/eating/drinking?
- Use the magnifying tool to enlarge the detail in the picture.
- Have you ever been to a party? Tell me about it.



2 Listen

Framework Objective: Listen with enjoyment and respond to... rhymes

- Listen to the nursery rhyme 'Pat a Cake, Pat a Cake'.
- Say the rhyme together.
 - Talk about what a baker is.
 - Have you ever made a cake?
 - Why do you put a cake in the oven?



4 Meet

Who's in the story?

- This is a story about Kipper.



5 Guess

Framework Objective: Speak clearly and audibly

- What might the story be about? What is Kipper wearing on his head? Who else is in the story?
- Encourage the children to take turns answering the questions.
- The cover appears without the title. Click 'next' to make it visible.
- Remind the children of the clues: book cover, photo, audio, film.

Framework Objective: Use talk to organise, sequence and clarify... feelings and events.

- Introduce the subject *baking cakes*.
- Talk about hygiene and safety when cooking.
- Try to remember what the chef does and what he uses.
- Discuss the events in order: First... Next... Then... .

Framework Objective: Know that print carries meaning and, in English, is read from left to right

- Click on 'play story' to listen to the story.
- Choose one toy and discuss how its expression changes through the story.
- At the end of the story, talk about why Mum was cross.
- Use the story book for independent and group reading.
