Occasionally, somebody does something so awful that it seems impossible to forgive them. Look at the way one mother deals with a drunken driver who killed her teenage daughter.

How does Kylie's mum deal with this situation?

She has clearly suffered a terrible shock and hates the man who killed her daughter. This is perfectly understandable, most of us would probably feel the same way. What she plans to do later is more questionable.

We don't know if Kylie's mum said this in the heat of the moment and didn't really mean it. Maybe it was a carefully considered reaction. Do you think she will wait around for the driver to serve his time in prison?

Think of the hatred that will build up inside Kylie's mum. Think of the stress it will cause her. Her health will suffer and she won't be able to concentrate on anything else. What will happen to her friends? What will happen to her if she really does kill the driver?
