

# Handel's *Giulio Cesare* at Glyndebourne

This summer Glyndebourne revives its award-winning production of Handel's opera *Giulio Cesare*, using the OUP edition of the work.



First presented at Glyndebourne in 2005, and recorded in co-production with Opus Arte, David McVicar's production went on to win the Opera Award at the 2006 South Bank Show Awards. This year Handel's grandest opera returns to the festival to mark Glyndebourne's contribution to the celebrations of the composer's 250th anniversary.

Using the Oxford University Press edition, edited and arranged by Winton Dean and Sarah Fuller, *Giulio Cesare* will once again be directed by David McVicar, with Laurence Cummings conducting. Sarah Connolly and Danielle de Niese return to lead the cast.
