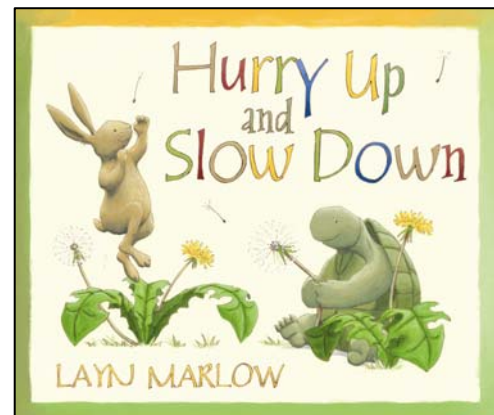


Hurry Up and Slow Down

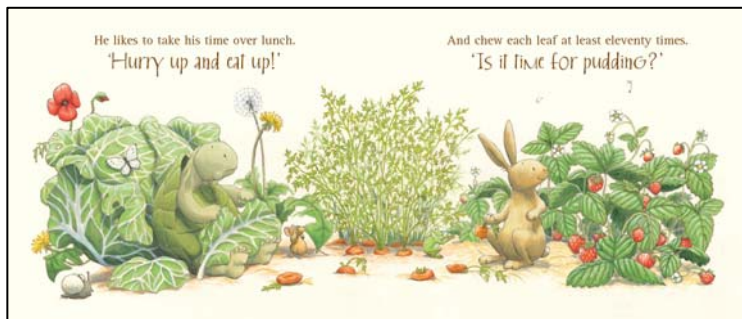
